

ORDINANCE NO. 123

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH NEW CASTLE, LAWRENCE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR SOLICITATION OF BUSINESS WITHIN THE BOROUGH, PROVIDING MEANS FOR ADMINISTRATION OF PERMITS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION HEREOF.

Be It Enacted and ordained and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of South New Castle, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, that:

Section 1. From and after the enactment of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person who has attained his sixteenth (16th) birthday to solicit business within the Borough of South New Castle without first having obtained a permit to do so from the Borough Secretary.

Section 2. "Solicitation of Business" when used in this ordinance shall mean attempting to sell, peddle or vend any goods or services by house to house place of business to place of business canvass.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Borough Secretary to receive applications for and to issue permits to qualified solicitors. Before issuing any such permit, the Borough Secretary shall be satisfied that the applicant for such permit represents a legitimate and reputable business.

Section 4. The Borough Secretary shall collect a fee of FIVE AND NO/100 (\$5.00) DOLLARS for each permit issued which fee shall be deposited in the General Fund of the Borough.

Section 5. Any person who shall be convicted of violation of this ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$100.00) DOLLARS and the costs of prosecution.
